

CENTRAL UNIVERSITY OF KARNATAKA

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

The University admits eligible candidates to various Integrated, Post Graduate and Ph.D. programmes mainly through CUCET 2017. The admissions will be offered on the basis of the order of merit in the entrance examination and as per the reservation rules. The candidates whose qualifying examination results are not declared at the time of admission will be given provisional admission and their admissions automatically stand cancelled if they fail to secure the required percentage of marks in their qualifying examination or fail in the said examination. The candidates so selected will have to give an undertaking in the format given in the prospectus to this effect. The candidates admitted to any of the programmes and whose results are still awaited at the time of admission need to submit the marks card of the qualifying examination to the Department concerned latest by 31 August 2017.

candidates are required to mark the answers in the OMR Sheet with blue or black ball-point pen during the test.
